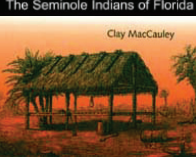

LAST WEEK IN ROTARY



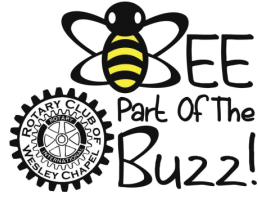

Just click VIEW My DATA (under the MEMBER tab), and then you may EDIT/change "your information," including the User ID and Password to values of your choice.
