Here is how you do it: Complete the sign-on procedure. You sign on by using your E-mail address as the User ID and your RI Member ID as your Password. Your RI Member ID is on your monthly ROTARIAN magazine just above your Name, or you can get it from your club secretary. Just click VIEW My DATA (under the MEMBER tab), and then you may EDIT/change “your information,” including the User ID and Password to values of your choice.
