LAST WEEK IN ROTARY

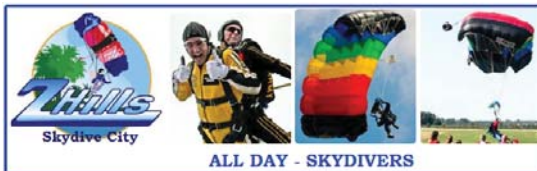
